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AU: Convention on Preventing and Combating Corruption

The first nationwide agreement on corruption adopted by the African Union since its establishment in July 2000.

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U.N.: Convention Against Corruption

A comprehensive set of standards and measures to promote international co-operation and domestic efforts in the fight to prevent corruption.

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U.K. Supreme Court of Judicature — Court of Appeal (Civil Division):

N. v. Secretary of State for the Home Department

The removal of an illegal immigrant receiving medical treatment for AIDS to Uganda did not amount to inhuman and degrading treatment and would not constitute a breach of Article 3 of the ECHR Convention.

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
ICSID: *Tecnicas Medioambientales Tecmed S.A. v. United Mexican States (Mexico)* (Additional Facility)

Mexico breached its obligations under the Bilateral Investment Treaty between Mexico and Spain by refusing to grant an investor's license to operate a waste confinement facility.

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CPA: The Statute of the Iraqi Special Tribunal

The Tribunal's Statute provides for jurisdiction over any Iraqi national or resident of Iraq accused of genocide, crimes against humanity, war crimes and violations of certain Iraqi laws.



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
