Preaching the Gospel

In an age when more and more people are ignorant of the Christian good news, there is a growing need for books which expound the faith in simple and vivid terms. Such a book is *The Christian Faith*, by David Read, Chaplain to Edinburgh University. Published at 6/- net by the English Universities Press in the famous TEACH YOURSELF series, this is a book both for those who are already Christians and for those outside who ask "What is Christianity?"

The Vitality of Faith is the title of a book of sermons by Murdo Ewen Macdonald, Minister of St. George's West Church, Edinburgh. Those who have heard this outstanding young preacher will expect to find the authentic challenge of Christian doctrine, offering mankind not systems of self-analysis but the Gospel of the Resurrection. *The Vitality of Faith* is published at 10/6 net.

Finally, a book to help all professing Christians in their vital task of bearing witness to their faith in the world. *Christian Words and Christian Meanings* (9/6 net), by John Burnaby, Regius Professor of Divinity in the University of Cambridge, writes to help us clarify in our minds the vague and sometimes shifting significance we attach to such words as Faith, Revelation and Atonement, so that we may know more fully the faith we proclaim.

The aim of this book is to give a Biblical account of the doctrine of the ministry as the humble participation of the whole Church, in the Royal Priesthood of Christ, and of the special gifts of the Spirit within the historical Church through which that Ministry is fulfilled. Emphasis is laid throughout on the fact that the Church is a Eucharistic fellowship in which its members are all subject to one another in the mutual service of love. This exposition is highly provocative but may help to reconcile many differences.
