

A tribute to the eminent pathologist and historian of medicine by nearly forty noted historians of science and medicine. In keeping with Professor Pagel's conviction that scientific and medical history must be examined as an organic whole, inseparable from its social and cultural setting, each contribution to these two volumes reflects not only the specific topic dealt with, but the underlying ideas and philosophies of the period and place. Among the general topics considered in these essays are the science and medicine of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, Paracelsus and his followers throughout Europe, and studies of medical science outside Europe; a comprehensive bibliography of Dr. Pagel's own published work completes the second volume.
