Prison psychiatry straddles the border between forensic and general adult psychiatry, although specialist skills are useful, for example in intellectual disability. Prison psychiatrists play a key role in the assessment and management of prisoners with a range of diagnoses. Working in prison requires a good grasp of mental health law, whether in ensuring that prisoners lacking capacity are appropriately treated, or transferring prisoners to secure hospital beds when needed. This module examines psychiatric specialties, physical health and prescribing in prisons, and outlines mental health legislation related to the prison population.
