
Diploma in Laryngology and Otology (D.L.O.) The Secretary reports to the two Royal Colleges that at the First Part of the Examination for the Diploma in Laryngology and Otology, held on December 8th and 11th, 1933, by Mr. E. M. Woodman and Mr. Sydney Scott, 26 Candidates presented themselves, eleven of whom passed; and that at the Second Part of the Examination, held on December 15th, 19th and 20th, 1933, by Mr. Walter Howarth and Mr. Lionel Colledge, twenty-three Candidates presented themselves, of whom twelve were found by the Examiners to be qualified for the Diploma.

Peroral Endoscopy Table

Fitted with Head Rest for BRONCHOSCOPY, ŒSOPHAGOSCOPY,
NASAL OPERATIONS Etc.

The head rest enables the operator himself to place the patient in the desired position for a variety of operations. All parts touched by the operator are sterilisable.

The apparatus is an elaboration of Haslinger's Bronchoscopic head rest, but its range of utility is extended to enable the patient to be supported with the shoulders beyond the end of the table for œsophagoscopy, and to be kept in the correct attitude during operations performed in the sitting or semi-sitting position.
