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

The Nordic Association of Linguists (NAL) is an organisation whose aim is to promote the interests of linguists, especially those working in the Nordic countries, and of linguists working specifically with the languages of the Nordic countries.

The activities of the Nordic Association of Liguists include:

- the Nordic Journal of Linguistics, published for the Association by Cambridge University Press;
- two conference series, the Scandinavian Conference of Linguistics and the International Conference on Nordic and General Linguistics, organised under the auspices of the Association (proceedings are published for both series);
- some financial support to graduate students in Nordic languages or linguistics.
