CD-ROM literature searching

The Library offers a literature search service using the following databases on CD-ROM; Excerpta Medica (Psychiatry and Neurosciences), ClinPSYC and Medline. The Library Committee has agreed that searches should be charged as follows:

College members (including inceptors)	Four searches per year free with subsequent searches charged at £10
non-members and funded projects	£25 per search.

All searches limited to 25 references with abstracts.

Additional references to be charged as new search.

Members wishing to undertake their own computer searches are requested to telephone in advance to ensure the computer is free.

Additional journals

The Library has recently added several new titles to its list of journal holdings. We would like to thank the Royal Society of Medicine for donating copies of their new *Journal of Medical Biography*, and Dr Paul Bowden for arranging a subscription to the *Journal of Forensic Psychiatry*. We are also grateful to Dr Max Fink for supplying volumes 1–3 of *Convulsive Therapy*, and donating the necessary funds for

binding our complete collection of this title. Two further journals, *Behavioral and Brain Sciences* and *Psychiatric Clinics of North America*, are now being supplied to the Library in exchange for subscriptions to the *British Journal of Psychiatry*.
