The main intention of Dieter Sanger's investigations is to examine the way in which the Apostle Paul deals with the tension between the promises of election and salvation given by God to Israel and the justification by faith in Jesus Christ for all believers. An analysis of Romans 1–4, 9–11 and Galatians 3 shows

that Paul understands God's promises to Israel strictly in a Christological sense. On the basis of this Christological perspective of Jewish and Christian hopes of salvation, all anti-Jewish interpretations of Pauline theology is mistaken.




