**CLINICAL AND SOCIAL FUNCTIONING, QUALITY OF LIFE, MALADJUSTMENT OF HIV-POSITIVE INJECTION-DRUG CONSUMERS**

**Objectives:** The epidemiology of HIV in Belarus, main trends in addiction treatment, attitude to rehabilitation of addicts with HIV are presented.

The correlation between the amount and characteristics of rehabilitating services and the grade of maladjustment is stressed.
